**Dear Parents** 

Development of school curriculum is a dynamic process responsive to the society and reflecting the needs and aspiration of the learners. It has been long felt that students graduating in various disciplines do not have the sense of enterprise and lack the skills and attitudes that will help them be entrepreneurs.

The Central Board of Secondary Education (CBSE) has responded to this situation and has introduced Entrepreneurship as an elective course for senior secondary classes in their affiliated schools. The Nation Education Policy too mentions it as a

Entrepreneurs are those unique set of people who have the ability to translate inventions or technologies into products and services. Entrepreneurship education equips students to seek out problem-solving opportunities, think creatively, take risks, accept failure as part of the growth process, and appreciate the correlation between hard work and success. It is aimed at making the young generation more imaginative, innovative and goal oriented.

I am pleased to share that an Entrepreneurship Pilot Program for a section of students of grade VIII was conducted in the academic year 2020-21 with an aim to successfully sow the seeds of entrepreneurship in the young minds and enable them to contribute their views and opinions like budding entrepreneurs. I am happy to share that 95% of the students found the sessions engaging while 100% felt that the programme helped them understand aspects related to entrepreneurship and added to their learning.

The overwhelming positive feedback from the parents and students is a strong testimony of the tremendous success of this pilot run, which has motivated us to implement it in the upcoming academic session for the students of grade VII. There will be 16 sessions, which will help learners develop entrepreneurship mindset. This programme will be part of the curriculum and one period every week shall be allocated for the same. The programme is priced at Rs 2750 for the academic year 2021-22.
