Both the papers will be a combination of objective and subjective type questions.	They will be a combination of objective and subjective type questions.
Objective type questions can include MCQs, True and False and Fill in the Blanks. Subjective type questions can include one word answer based questions (Labelling / Map Pointing) and answer in one / two sentences. There will be questions for which students will need to upload hand written answers for all subjects. Answer script for II and III Language will be hand written and uploaded.
