Grades I and II

- One test based on the portion.
- Each test to be of 20 marks.
- The exam will start at 9.40 am sharp.
- Tests will be conducted using Google Form.

Grades III to V

- We recommend the exam to be conducted offline for all learners, in case of illness/other genuine reason a prior permission via an application raised to class teacher must be taken.
- For children giving **online exam** the Google Form with the entire question paper will be created. Upload option will be provided at the end of the form. Child will have to upload the pdf of compiled answer script within 20 minutes of completion of test.
- 2 tests totaling 60 marks will be conducted.
- Test I and Test II both will be handwritten by the students and submitted / uploaded. Tests will be conducted using Google Forms as well as offline.
- The exam will start at 9.40 am sharp
- Test will be a combination of objective and subjective type questions.
- Student audio and video to be switched on for the entire duration of the test.
- Parents are requested to ensure students appear for the tests in a fair manner.
- Students must upload the answer script within the stipulated time i.e. not exceeding 20 minutes post the conclusion of test.

Guidelines--

Grades VI to VIII

Grades VI to VIII 1 test totaling to 80 marks will be conducted in Annual Examination.

We recommend the exam to be conducted offline for all learners, in case of illness/other genuine reason a prior permission via an application raised to class teacher must be taken.

For children giving **online exam** the Google Form with the entire question paper will be created. Upload option will be provided at the end of the form. Child will have to upload the pdf of compiled answer script within 20 minutes of completion of test. Further student need to comply with the following in case of online exam:-

- Students to be seated in a quiet place ensuring correct posture.
- Required writing material like sheets of paper, pen, pencil and any other required—stationery should be kept ready before the commencement of the test
- Student audio and video to be switched on for the entire duration of the test.
- Parents should be requested to ensure students appear for the tests in a fair manner.
- Students must inform the teacher if they lose internet connectivity or face problems in uploading the answer scripts
