The contestants were judged on parameters like originality, relevance of purpose, presentation, abstract, conclusions, time management and ability to field questions. Our teachers Ms. Vandita Bhatnagar, Ms. Anupriya Singh, Ms. Monika Solanki, Ms. Mona Sharma, Ms. Anjana Choudhary, Ms. Meenu Kumawat, Ms. Geetika Bansal, Ms. Prateeksha Singh, Ms. Purnima Sharma and Ms. Swati Shukla participated in this event and confidently presented their case studies which included their objective, challenges faced by them in the class, methods applied by them and what changes they brought about using different strategies. They supported the same with proper evidences. It was quite an enriching learning experience for the teachers.

We share with great pride that our teachers, **Ms. Purnima Sharma** and **Ms. Prateeksha Singh** qualified for the National round of LBE to be conducted in Bangalore on 1<sup>st</sup> February.

## MOM AND ME

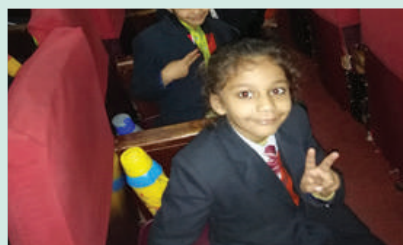

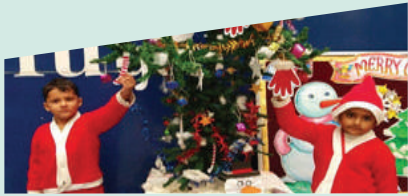
