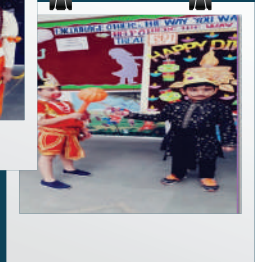
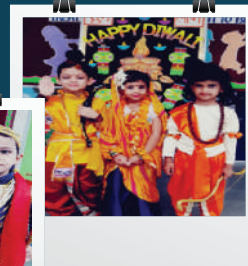

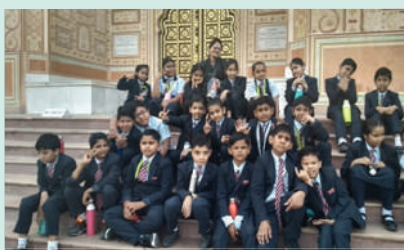
SPECIAL ASSEMBLY ON EID

FIELD TRIP

Field trips are an important component of experiential learning. This helps the learners to relate their classroom learning to real life. Keeping the same in mind the students of **grades IV and V** were taken to Birla Planetarium on **16th November 2018**. The students could experience the grandeur of the night sky, the heavenly bodies and the planets.

HSCP (E-SAFETY)

On Saturday, **17th November** the school safeguarding officer Ms. Pratibha Rathore conducted an E-safety session for the students of **grades V to VIII**. Students were briefed on the guidelines and norms as defined by the law. It aimed at creating awareness among the students about the care they need to take while exploring the e-world and cyber safety.

FIRST AID TRAINING OF PRE-PRIMARY

Teacher of Pre-primary classes took a special session on first-aid with the students of pre-primary on **Monday, 19th November 2018**. Students were shown the first aid kit, along with the sterile gauze pads, band-aids antiseptic wipes, dettol, adhesive tape, etc. Students were informed about how and when to apply which antiseptic and difference between band-aid and bandages. Teachers also demonstrated how to apply antiseptic on a wound. They were explicitly cautioned about not touching any of these themselves but seeking adult help if and when the need arises.

INTER - HOUSE QUIZ COMPETITION

An Inter-House Quiz Competition was held at Pearson School on **November 26th, 2018**. The quiz began with the introduction of all the four houses and its members viz- Topaz, Ruby, Emerald and Sapphire.

The teams participated with great enthusiasm and adeptly answered all the questions. Every round was a mixed bag with questions from history, sports, books, literature, vocabulary and science. The **Ruby House** won the competition scoring **74 points** followed by **Sapphire House with 51 points**.

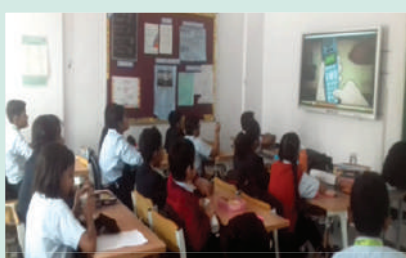
SPECIAL ASSEMBLY ON SAFEGUARDING

SESSION ON EXAM STRESS MANAGEMENT

On Saturday, **24th November 2018** a session on **Healthy Living and Exam Stress** was conducted by the doctors from Shelby hospital for the students of grade VII to X. They spoke to the students how stress would impact their preparation and performance and how to deal with it.

HEALTH SAFETY AND CHILD PROTECTION TRAINING

Regular trainings and workshops prove extremely beneficial for the reinforcement of any area of concern and HSCP being one of the cornerstones of Pearson School Jaipur, we ensure that regular workshops are conducted so that our students are safe at all times. Keeping the same in mind a workshop was taken up by Ms. Pratibha Rathore, the HSCP coordinator on POCSO Act and bullying. Further, the children were shown "Komal" video to create awareness in a very subtle manner and conveying the message to our children that they should never feel scared and report if they face any uncomfortable situation.

CLEANLINESS DRIVE

As part of the cleanliness drive our school took an initiative and went on a "Swachhta Abhiyan" around the school. The students and teachers of **grades IX and X** set an exemplary example of cleaning our surrounding which was appreciated by one and all.

PARENTS' TALK

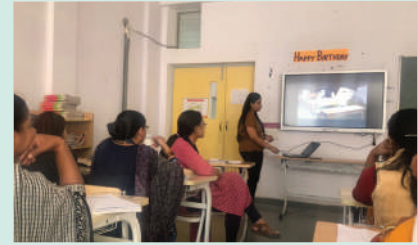
