New initiatives and programmes - We at Pearson always believe in initiating and developing programs which will enhance the growth of a child. As a part of this initiative we have launched the following programs in the Academic Session 2017-18.





MYPEDIA - MyPedia Curriculum (Nursery- Grade -V) MyPedia is the **only fully-integrated learning program** that promises measurable improvement in cognitive skills of the learners.

It consists of specially crafted Course Books that use an inter-disciplinary learning approach and a robust pedagogy.

The worksheets are designed for multiple difficulty levels with an assessment rubric that helps to record overall performance of the learner.

The easy-to-access videos are mapped to chapters taught in class. The HomeApp which parents' can install on their phones is for students to be able to access class videos and practice assignments.

Reports will cater to all levels of learning - student, teacher and school.

SPORTS ACTIVITIES - With an aim to develop stamina, agility and self-defense skills we have initiated Skating and Martial Art classes for all the students of Grades-I-VIII.

GROW- READING PROGRAM(GRADES I TO IV) - GROW Programme is a programme to encourage reading amongst children. It is a simple process designed to promote reading for joy. It motivates child to start enjoying reading as well as develops his/her vocabulary which further enriches and helps in his language skills.

15 BOOKS READING CAMPAIGN (GRADE V TO IX) - This campaign aims at developing and enhancing reading skills among the students as well develop a love for books – as it is rightly said that – BOOKS ARE MAN'S BEST FRIENDS.

Once a student has read a book then he/she presents a review in the assembly which helps in improving their oratory and presentation skills. A child who reads 15 books in a session is rewarded with a certificate of achievement. This programme is for the students of grades V to IX.
