### **PROGRAMMES AT SCHOOL**

**REOPENING OF SCHOOL** - After the summer break the school reopened on Monday 3<sup>rd</sup> July. The students came back to school totally re-energised and recharged. The first day saw every one sharing their holiday stories of outings and trips. We were all set to start learning and sharing new things.

**TEACHERS' ORIENTATION PROGRAMME** - We at Pearson have always believed in the process of learning and growing for students as well as teachers. With this thought in mind a Teacher Orientation Programme was conducted from 22<sup>nd</sup> June to 29<sup>th</sup> June. The aim of the sessions was to enhance the knowledge of the teachers and equip them with skills to ensure better teaching learning process.

**PARENT ORIENTATION PROGRAMME** - The school, along with parents, plays a significant role in the growth of a child. With this thought in mind, a Parent Orientation session was conducted on Saturday, 1<sup>st</sup> July. The parents were briefed on the various academic processes followed at the school and how they aim to enhance the learning of the student. These sessions were conducted by Ms. Nidhi Thapar, Regional Lead Academics at Pearson School Jaipur.

**SPECIAL ASSEMBLY ON SAFETY IN PLAYGROUNDS** - Teaching kids how to play safely is important. If they know the rules of the





playground, they're less likely to get hurt. Safe playground equipment and adult supervision are extremely important, but it's only half of the equation: Kids must know how to be safe and act responsibly at the playground. On 5<sup>th</sup> of July 2017, a special assembly was conducted by the students of grade-V. It dealt with the Safety Rules that we should follow while at the playgrounds. The students presented different rules which should be followed at the playground.

**WORLD CONSERVATION DAY** - The World Conservation day is celebrated with a view to Conserve nature and natural resources for the future generations. Hence this day is celebrated to create awareness among the children and sensitize them towards the environment. To attain the goal of 'Save Earth', we should not indulge in any activities which damage the environment, as well as conserve the other basic necessities such as electricity, water, food etc.

**TREE PLANTATION** - The theme for Class Assembly in the second week of July was Nature Conservation. On 19<sup>th</sup> of July 2017, Tree Plantation was done by the tiny tots of grades I and II. They planted a variety of saplings of trees like - Gulmohar, Neem etc. They also learnt how to take care of them, such as regularly watering them. They were also taught about the importance of planting trees and plants. They took a vow to plant as many trees as possible.

**BOOK MARK MAKING AND SLOGAN WRITING COMPETITION** - On 22<sup>nd</sup> July the school conducted an inter-house Book Mark Making competition for students of grades III to V and Slogan Writing for grades VI to IX. The topic was - "Nature Conservation". The need of the hour is Nature conversation. The activity was aimed at creating awareness and a sense of responsibility amongst the students towards Mother Nature. Students participated in the activity with energy and enthusiasm and had a lot of fun expressing themselves creatively.

**FIELD TRIP** - Learning should never be confined to the classroom and school building. Field Trips can be valuable and practical leaning opportunities to help to bring the life the subjects that students are studying in the classroom. With this thought in mind, the students of grades I to III went on a field trip to Nehru Park on 15<sup>th</sup> July 2017. At the park they observed nature very closely, they were taught to study the large variety of plant life and put to use their text book knowledge.

**FIRE EVACUATION DRILL** - Health Safety and Safeguarding being an important cornerstone of Pearson Schools, various programmes are regularly conducted in school to ensure awareness and involvement of all the stakeholders. One such process is FIRE EVACUATION DRILLS. On 28<sup>th</sup> July 2017, a fire evacuation drill was conducted in the school. It was conducted to

check the alertness of all those present in the school premises. It began when the fire alarm rang; the students and staff immediately started evacuating the building and started assembling at the designated place i.e. the Basketball Court. The entire evacuation was completed within 3 minutes. Once all had assembled a head count of all the students was done by the class teachers followed by a briefing by the Principal.

**CIVIC SENSE** - 'We never fail when we try to do our duty; we always fail when we neglect to do it'. Civic sense is nothing but social ethics. A lot of people assume that civic sense is just about- keeping the road, streets and public places clean. But civic sense is more than that. It has to do with being law abiding, respecting others, using the three golden words - 'Sorry, Please and thank you', maintaining decorum in public places, showing kindness, helping others etc. A set of activities as well as videos on Civic Sense were organised for the students of Primary section. They taught the students the importance and value of these invaluable values.

**SAFE AND UNSAFE TOUCH** - It is important to make the students aware of Safe Touch and Unsafe Touch. A program with an aim to bring awareness among the students about how to prevent and act in certain situations like say 'No' when being touched or held uncomfortably, 'Go' to people in their Safe Circle (Parents, teachers & SG Officer) - people who could help and protect them and 'TELL' experiences if they had witnessed or experienced any unsafe situation without keeping any secret. Students were explained to respect their bodies and also others'. The program concluded on a positive note and lots of learning to take away. Students were shown the movie 'KOMAL' on Safe Touch and Unsafe touch and were explained to respect their bodies and also others'.

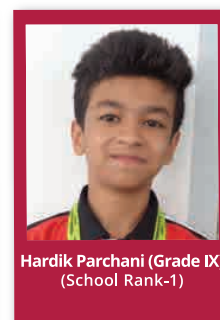
