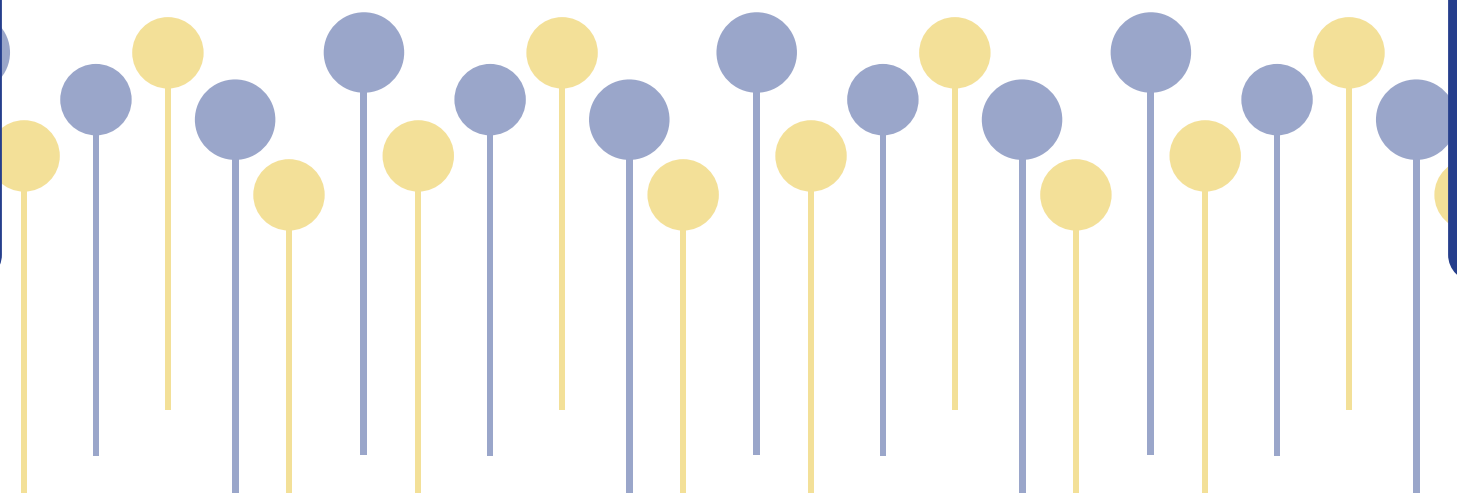
Life Beyond Technology

First Aid Training

Enhancing Staff Preparedness: NIST-First Aid & Fire Safety Training at Ryan Education School Jaipur.

On 15th February 2025, Ryan Education School Jaipur conducted a comprehensive NIST-First Aid and Fire Safety Training program for its staff members. This initiative aimed to equip the staff with essential knowledge and skills to respond effectively in emergency situations.

Fire Safety Training

The fire safety training session covered critical topics, including:

- The basics of the fire triangle and concepts of fire spread.
- Fire warning equipment and fire detection systems.
- Principles of fire extinguishing and the PASS technique.
- Emergency requirements and procedures.

First Aid Training

The first aid training session focused on:

- The importance of a first aid kit and recognizing emergencies.
- Basic first aid techniques for bleeding, cuts, grazes, fractures, and burns.

- Practical demonstrations of cardio-pulmonary resuscitation (CPR) and automated external defibrillator (AED) usage.

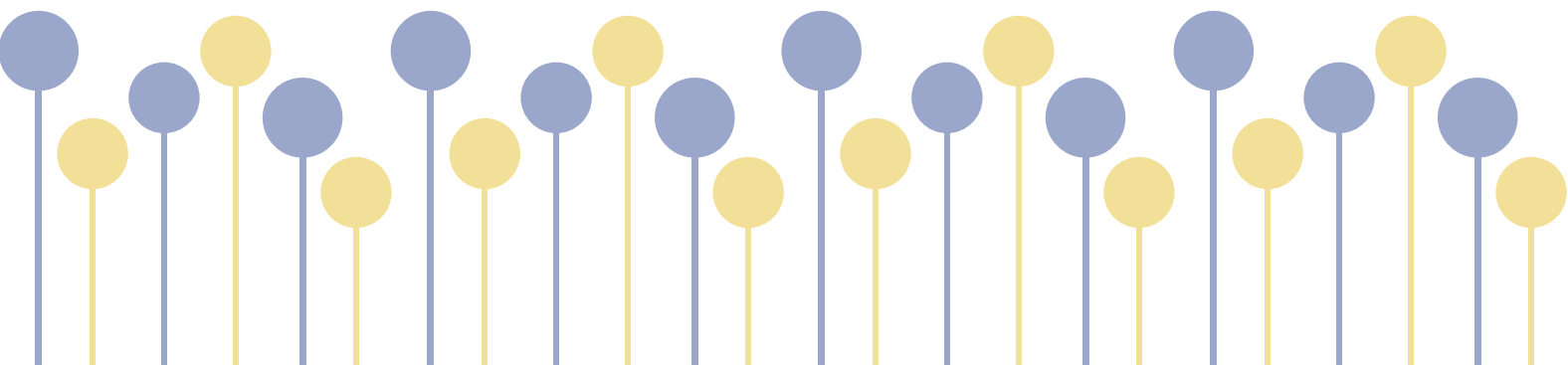
